A Psalm of Asaph.

- 1 The Mighty One, God the LORD, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.

- ⁹I will not accept a bull from your house or goats from your folds.

- Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High,
- ¹⁵ and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me."
- ¹⁶ But to the wicked God says:

"What right have you to recite my statutes or take my covenant on your lips?

¹⁷ For you hate discipline,

and you cast my words behind you.

- ¹⁸ If you see a thief, you are pleased with him, and you keep company with adulterers.
- ¹⁹ "You give your mouth free rein for evil, and your tongue frames deceit.
- ²⁰ You sit and speak against your brother; you slander your own mother's son.
- ²¹These things you have done, and I have been silent; you thought that I was one like yourself.

But now I rebuke you and lay the charge before you.

- ²² "Mark this, then, you who forget God, lest I tear you apart, and there be none to deliver!
- ²³ The one who offers thanksgiving as his sacrifice glorifies me; to one who orders his way rightly.
