





A New Heart for Our Beloved Campus

The new Sanctuary completes a vision nearly a decade in the making—a permanent home for Lord’s Day worship that gathers Providence Presbyterian’s growing congregation beneath soaring timber trusses and abundant natural light.

Designed in the same warm brick and limestone that define the existing campus, the 13,690-square-foot building creates a gracious cloister courtyard at the heart of the church grounds while offering seating for over 800 worshipers in fixed oak pews.

Traditional ecclesiastical elements—a raised chancel, centered pulpit, and luminous art glass window—orient every seat toward the proclamation of God’s Word, while a welcoming narthex, family parlor, and covered walkways ensure that all who enter find rest and belonging.
